ENTRIES

Notification of vacant positions by 7th July 2024

Preliminary entries by 7th July 2024:

State members are to submit the preliminary numbers for each division to the competitors steward (Margaret Blunden) using the form provided in Form 1. This will enable other states to fill any vacant positions.

Final entries by 7th July 2024:

State members are to submit the final numbers for each division to the competitors steward (Margaret Blunden) using the form provided Form 2.

FEES

Entry fee will be charged to each state member based on the number of skaters entered into the competition. \$80 will be charged to state association for each skater entered, including skater who's filling in the vacant position for other state. E.g. IRNSW has entered 10 skaters leaving 10 vacant positions, of which 4 were filled by VIC and 6 by QLD. IRNSW will be charged \$800, VIC charged with additional \$320 and QIRA with an additional \$480. State will not be charged for reserve skater unless the reserve skater was utilised during the competition.

- Day 2: Sunday 28th July 9:00am to 12:30pm (start time is subject to the number of entries and races)

Important:

- For practical reasons, it will NOT be possible to attend just the presentation. A meal must be paid for.
- State Associations must provide a list of attendees (competitors and non-competitors including the numbers of adults and children) who will be attending the lunch **by no later than Sun 14th July**.
- **State Associations are responsible to collect lunch money from their members and make a lump sum payment to AIR, by no later than Sun 14th July: BSB: 062000, account no: 20829381, reference: name of association Duke lunch (e.g. VIC Duke lunch)**
- It will not be possible to pay for the presentation after Sun 14th July or on the day
- State members are responsible to collect the lunch tickets for the purchased quantity on day 1 of the competition.

VOLUNTEERS

Each state will be required to provide volunteers for the event. For every 3 skaters the state association entered, 1 volunteer is to be provided. E.g. If the state is entering 3 or 4 skaters, then it needs to provide 1 volunteer. If the state is entering 5 or 6 skaters, then it needs to provide 2 volunteers. For each volunteer position that the state member cannot provide, a \$50 charge will apply to the state member for each required but vacant position. The money will then go towards the volunteer amenities and refreshments.
